August. From the first of July, there were some changes to Australia's superannuation system. They affect people differently depending on personal circumstances. The changes could affect you now, or in the future, so it's important to find out if you're impacted. If you haven't already, read more about these changes by visiting ato.gov.au/superchanges. You can also find information on our Seniors Update Facebook and Twitter accounts.

Census date is approaching for university students. This is the last day you can end your enrolment without needing to pay fees or adding to your HELP debt. If you're withdrawing from study, deferring for a semester or changing to part time, make sure you advise Centrelink. There's more information and a step by step guide for updating study details on our website.

Finally I'd like to talk about Digital Services. Centrelink has online services, mobile app and phone self-service making it quick and easy to let us know when things change. It's important to keep Centrelink up to date about changes in your circumstances. Also don't ignore any letters we send you, and always respond to the requests in the letter by the due date.
